


BAY AREA RANGELANDS

Conservation Status



Rangelands in the Bay Area cover ~1.9 million acres or ~41% of the region.

- ~585,000 acres are owned by public agencies and conservation organizations.
- ~150,000 acres are protected by conservation easements and are privately owned.
- ~1,200,000 acres are privately owned.
