


BAY AREA RANGELANDS

Rangeland Vegetation Types



In the ten-county Bay Area, rangelands cover ~1.9 million acres or 41% of the region. Rangelands are grassland, woodland and shrubland vegetation types that are suitable for livestock grazing. Not all rangelands are grazed.
