The system is also available to the public. Using hydrangeas as an example, type in "hydrangea pests and diseases UC IPM" on your browser. IPM stands for Integrated Pest Management. A topic heading appears, click on that, and a full page of text dealing with pests and diseases opens. Click on any one problem, and complete background information appears, including prevention, treatment, and identification of problems.
