

Creating Partnerships with Native American Tribes Workshop

May 9-10, 2017

Do you work with tribal partners? Do you want to learn more about working with tribes? Did you know there are over 25 federally recognized Indian reservations in Southern California?

In partnership with the Pala Band of Mission Indians, UCCE is hosting a workshop designed to educate extension professionals who work with tribes and increase their understanding of tribal issues as they relate to extension programs.

The workshop will be on the Pala reservation on May 9-10. Overnight accommodations are available at the Pala resort.

Topics to be covered during the workshop will include: History of Southern California Indians, Tribal Governments, Cultural Norms and Contemporary Tribal Life, Traditional Ecological Knowledge, Examples of Partnering with Tribes from UCCE and local agencies.
