Lavender Sniffy Beanbags



A lavender sniffy beanbag is a playful sachet to toss and sniff. The uplifting scent is calming and relaxing.

What you need: Colorful cotton fabric, lavender buds, pinto or kidney beans, needle and thread

What to do:

- 1. Cut two 4" squares from cotton fabric.
- 2. Lay one square on top of another. (colorful sides facing each other)
- 3. To make the bag, sew three of the four sides with a ¼ seam.
- 4. Fill the bag with ¼ cup lavender and ¼ cup pinto beans.
- 5. Use the thread and needle to sew the 4th side closed.

Other herbs and spices to fill beanbags

- Chunks of cinnamon
- Dried peppermint and spearmint leaves
- Dried lemon verbena, spearmint, and rosemary
- Dried rose petals and lavender
