GLENN COUNTY 4-H STAFF REPORT

REPRESENTING 4-H

The 4-H Code of Conduct is a set of guidelines that apply to all members when participating in 4-H events. You need to read and sign the Code of Conduct each year when enrolling as a member/leader and should have a copy on hand. It is very important that everyone abides by these rules to create a safe environment in the program. Younger 4-H members look up to older youth and adults as role models. Be aware of your actions in and outside of 4-H settings and remember that you have a chance to change someone's life in a positive way as you fulfill your responsibilities throughout your projects and club.

REMEMBER: Do not hold meetings until you are completely enrolled, new online leaders trainings completed, and certified. Please do so as soon as possible. Please read the guidelines below:

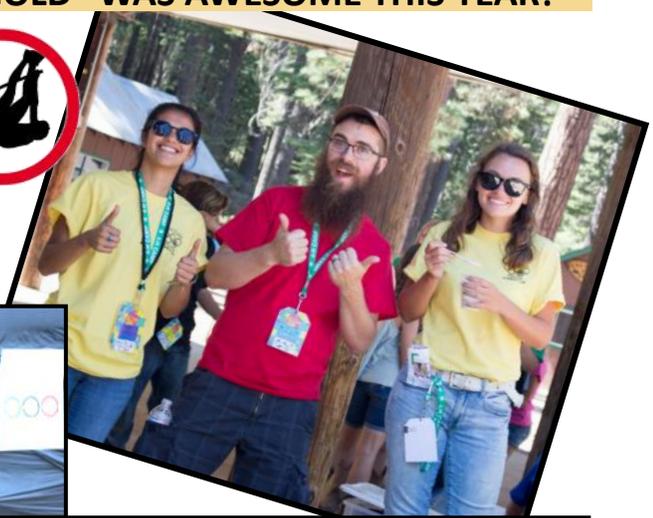
- ♦ **Safety First** As the 4-H project leader, you are entrusted with a great responsibility. An important area in this development is safety. For more details go to: http://safety.ucanr.org/4-H_Resources/Clover_Safe_Notes_by_Project_Area/
- ♦ **Supervision of Members** There must always be at least two (2) adults present at 4-H programs, project meetings, club meetings, events and activities. These adults can be two appointed adult volunteer leaders or one appointed adult leader and another adult (who is at least 21 years of age) or a 4-H Youth Development staff member.
- ♦ **Safety Requirements For Transporting Members** All leaders who transport youth are required to have a valid California Driver's License, carry their own automobile liability and accident insurance, use a safe vehicle and have a seat belt for each passenger. It is illegal to ride in the back of a pickup truck in California. When transporting youth to or from 4-H programs, events and activities, an adult cannot be alone in a vehicle with a youth, other than their own child, without advanced written permission from the youth's parents and a signed treatment authorization form.

NATIONAL YOUTH SCIENCE DAY-OCTOBER 3, 2018



This October, 4-H and Google will launch an exciting National Youth Science Day challenge, "Code Your World", which invites kids to get involved in computer science through hands-on doing.

Code Your World is a four-part computer science (CS) challenge that teaches kids to apply CS to the world around them through hands-on activities. Developed by West Virginia University Extension Service and Google, it includes a computer-based

activity on Google's CS First platform and three unplugged activities that bring coding to life through games and interaction.

Code Your World uses games and hands-on fun to teach kids important CS and computational thinking concepts, and is perfect for first-time and beginner coders ages 8-14.
