- 1. To complete this project, the member must atten I all hours of instruction offered. At least one "make up" meeting will be offered to maintain the hours required to complete his project successfully and be eligible to return next year at d count in your record book. Member and leader must agree upon, and complete the make-up meeting.
- 2. Vegetable Judging is a project that requires a lot of memorization and repetition, so we will be having 4-6 meetings lasting two or three hours. F articipation in 3 meetings is required, and self-study is accepted for the rest, but participation in all meetings is strongly recommended to get the most out of the project.
- 3. Makeup projects will be available upon request but must be completed to count for a meeting.
- 4. Notify project leader in advance if you will be late or absent.
- 5. Treat others with respect
- 6. Be GREAT listeners and only handle samples as directed by the project leaders
- 7. Always wash hands after handling samples
- 8. Report any accidents or injuries IMMEDIATELY to the project leader
- 9. Arrive and leave on time
- 10. Once the project meeting dates are announced you are responsible for keeping a calendar of the upcoming meetings
- 11. Members are responsible for transportation and participation in any Vegetable Judging contests.
- 12. All members (primary members- this is optiona) must complete an annual project report
