Week 1: The Basic Basics – Soil, water, sun, tools, journal, and vocabulary

Week 2: Garden to Table – Vegetables, fruit, herbs, and pest management.

Week 3: Best Plants for Riverside County – Drought tolerant and California native plants, invasive plants and fire preparedness.
