

FASHION REVUE & SEWING PROJECTS

Do you like to shop for clothes, make costumes, or sew your own clothes? If that sounds like you, now is a good time to plan to enter County Fashion Revue. It will be part of 4-H Fest in April 2021. We don't know yet if it will be in person or a virtual event, but it will happen! The 5 categories for Fashion Revue have been carried over from last year because many counties were unable to hold their events. The requirement to make the entries as part of a sewing project has been removed for all categories. This means that any member in 4-H may enter any of the 5 categories! The categories are Traditional (garment or outfit sewn by the member), Consumer Science Purchased \$40 limit (with a receipt for every item showing), Vintage Challenge (garment our outfit sewn by member), Box Challenge (sew garment or outfit using items listed), and Cosplay Challenge (create a costume, does not need to be sewn). For complete category rules, see the listing at https://ucanr.edu/sites/sfd/Competitions/State_Fashion_Revue/. Our county follows the same category rules as State Fashion Revue so our County Winners can advance to the state event. Primary members can enter at the county level only. State Fashion Revue will be a virtual event in May 2021.

Are you signed up for Sewing project and it hasn't met this year? Some projects have been able to meet via Zoom, but sewing is a little more difficult to teach virtually. The University of California and the local Public Health Department have rules in place to keep project leaders and members safe. It is complicated, but it may be possible for small groups to meet in person. Contact your project leader to find out, either Sue Moore in Sonora at 209-743-2020 or Carol Willmon in Groveland at 209-768-7528. Even if you're not able to sew with a project group, you are still encouraged to create an outfit for Fashion Revue. Talk to Sue or Carol with questions or for ideas.

State Fashion Revue 2021 is sponsoring two Service Projects. The first is Port Pillows for chemotherapy patients (flyer attached). They're easy to sew and can be made out of small pieces of fabric. We will arrange to donate them here in Tuolumne County to the cancer Center. Of course, we hope all 4-H sewers are still making masks for yourselves, your families, and friends. The newest guidelines say they should beat least 2 layers and they help protect wearer and others.

- 2.Complete the online training at https://campus.extension.org/. (The training is called 2020-21 New California Volunteer, and then enrollment key is Tuolumne).
- 3. Payment for volunteers this year is covered by the Tuolumne 4-H Council.
- 4. Get fingerprinted by the DOJ.
- 5.Attend the one hour virtual New Adult Volunteer Orientation <u>(rsvp here)</u>.
