Three \$500 scholarships to be awarded, if deserving, to qualifying 4-H members. Youth may apply for one, two or all three scholarships on the same application.

Both require that the student has shown small livestock at the Mother Lode Fair within five years of application, but the requested information and award criteria are different. COVID-19 UPDATE

Good day,

We have been following the Governor's new stay-at-home orders and would like to give you guidance on how it affects UCANR programming. These orders supersede the industry guidance for the colored tiers which allowed us to have in person indoor/outdoor meetings depending on what tier your county was in.

This means that if your county's region is placed in a stay-at-home order due to limited ICU bed capacity, we must cease ALL in person activities. El Dorado and Amador fall within the Sacramento Region, while Calaveras and Tuolumne fall within the San Joaquin region. There are exceptions for critical research and essential activities so please contact us if you think your work fits into this category. I know this is frustrating news for many, as we were just starting to have small in person meetings again. Please know as soon as the orders are lifted, activities can resume based on the tier your county is placed in and on the safety plans submitted to our office. Our number one goal is to keep our clientele safe.
