The purpose of the 4-H presentation night is to help 4-H youth learn how to research a subject, organize their ideas in a logical order and then communicate the idea by showing and/or telling. There are several categories for the youth to choose from. The categories: are Demonstrations and Illustrated Talks, Science and Engineering Presentations, Educational Displays, Prepared Speeches, Impromptu Speeches, Interpretive Reading, "Share the 4-H Fun" Skits, and Cultural Arts Presentations.
