Tuolumne Council Scholarships

Three \$500 scholarships to be awarded, if deserving, to qualifying 4-H members. Youth may apply for one, two or all three scholarships on the same application.

Small Livestock Association

An eligible student may apply for both scholarships but can only receive one. Both require that the student has shown small livestock at the Mother Lode Fair within five years of application, but the requested information and award criteria are different. COVID-19 UPDATE
