

All Glenn County junior exhibitors need to have this training complete by the entry YOUTH QUALITY CARE ANIMALS close date on Monday, April 20, 2022. Trainings will only be offered online for

\$12.00 per exhibitor. To register and completed this training, please visit: yqca.org. The confirmation number received upon completion must be entered into your Glenn County Fair online entry. Glenn County Fair online entries will open Saturday, February 19, 2022.

What does this mean for 4-H?

4-H does not have any management responsibilities regarding the YQCA. The fairs are responsible for letting exhibitors know about the requirement and when the training needs to be completed. 4-H staff are not responsible for notifications, inperson trainings or verification of certificates. How does an exhibitor get their certificate of completion from the Online Course?

A youth who is taking the YQCA training online would need a pass rate of 80% on a series of three quizzes to earn certification. They can repeat the module if needed. Youth will be able to download, print, or access their certificate number after passing, from the course website at: https://yqca.learngrow.io/Account/ Login.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AWARD


