Grant Programs of Interest - Agricultural

- **In 2022**
 - **Moyer** - Carl Moyer Program
 - \approx \$22 M
 - **FARMER** - Funding Agricultural Replacement Measures for Emission Reductions
 - \approx \$2 ½ M



Maximum Grant Funding

| Equipment Type | Project | Max Grant Funding* |
|--------------------------------|---|-----------------------|
| Off-road Equipment | Replacement | 80% of eligible costs |
| Utility Terrain Vehicle (UTV) | Electric Replacement | 75% of eligible costs |
| Infrastructure | Agricultural Pump Electrification / Charging Stations | 65% of eligible costs |
| On-road Trucks (> 14,000 GVWR) | Replacement | 80% of eligible costs |

Action Items - What You Need To Do Now

1. Sign-up for APCD email listserv
2. Create an [online application account](#)
3. Review APCD's [“Preparing for an Upcoming Solicitation” webpage](#)
4. Gather usage documentation for the past 24 months
 - *Hour meter records, mileage, etc.*
5. Proof of equipment ownership
 - *Bill of sale, title, or other approved documentation*



Action Items - What You Need To Do Now

5. Gather vehicle and engine information
 - *Model numbers, serial numbers, horsepower, engine families, etc.*
6. Engines and equipment must have clean legible labels (serial numbers, etc.)
7. Meet with vendors or dealers about proposed new equipment
8. **Be ready to submit an application to APCD**
