



- 1. Posters designed by 4-H members can be hand drawn or designed by computer.
- 2. Poster size can be 8.5×11 up to 11×17 ($\frac{1}{2}$ poster board size is 11×14)
- 3. Must include:
 - 4-H clover
 - Say something that encourages the joining of 4-H.
 - Dates for upcoming meetings of your club.
 - Sample projects that offered in your club.
 - Pictures (printed or hand drawn) in color.
 - Contact info for 4-H office or individual club/leader. (4-H office: 209-533-6990)
 - Should say "National 4-H Week" and dates of 4-H week (October 2-8, 2022)
- 4. Drop off poster to the 4-H office by September 30th by noon or give to Sue Moore at the Mother Lode Fairgrounds Livestock area on Saturday, October 1 between 9-4 or on Sunday, October 2 between 1-2 pm
- 5. Put your info on the back of the poster
 - Name
 - Age
 - 4-H Club
- 6. Ribbons and medals will be awarded at Achievement Night for each age category.
- 7. Posters may be taken home from Achievement Night or picked up at the 4-H Office
- 8. To enter into the special drawing for a 4-H T-shirt (we will order your size):



Returning Volunteers

- 1. Enroll through 4hOnline.
- 2. Watch 2022-2023 Returning Volunteer eXtension Online Courses.

New Volunteers

- 1. Complete online interest survey
- 2. Enroll through 4hOnline
- 3. Council is covering enrollment fee
- 4. Watch 2022-2023 California New Volunteer eXtension Online Courses

(takes approximately 3 hours and can be broken up into 20 minute sections)

- 5. Complete DOJ fingerprinting
- 6. Attend two hour in person or online orientation

Important: All returning volunteers must complete their enrollment by Dec. 31. If not finished, your enrollment will be sent back and you will not be eligible to lead a project for the 2022-2023 Program Year.
