

# How to Apply for NRCS Programs

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# EQIP and CSP Application

- NRCS has one application (3 pager) for our main programs.
- Land Eligibility must be established prior to funding and ranking.
- Project site visit required.
- Funding periods are typically March through September.

# Typical Practices FY22 costs

- Livestock Pipeline: HDPE (\$2.35/ft)
- Tank: \$1.31/gal.
- Trough: Stock Trough, >300 to 600 gal. (\$3.32/gal)
- Well: Drilled, 200-400 ft deep (\$12,469)
- Pumping Plant: Solar Powered 1 to 3 HP (\$6,970 each)
- Spring Development: \$3,171 each.
- Fence: Barbed/smooth wire (\$4.11/ft)

# Top EQIP Practices by \$\$ (2021) Mon Co.

- 382 Fence: \$151,725
- 587 Structure for Water Control: \$96,825
- 533 Pumping Plant: \$87,268
- 614 Watering Facility: \$82,822
- 516 Livestock Pipeline: \$61,386
- 325 High Tunnel System: \$53,996
