

GOLDEN JOHNNY LIVESTOCK AWARD CRITERIA
LARGE ANIMALS
(CATTLE, SWINE, SHEEP & ALL GOATS)

The clean stalls and animal presentations are an important part of the overall Livestock Program of the El Dorado County Fair. All Junior exhibitors are invited to design and decorate their areas with educational displays regarding their project, as well as implement a plan to keep their area clean and attractive looking. An anonymous committee using the criteria below will do judging for these awards.

The organization with the highest overall cumulative score will win the 2023 Golden Johnny Trophy for the Large Animal category. Any displays that are removed prior to 6:00pm on Sunday, June 18th will automatically be disqualified from the competition.

In order to be eligible for the Golden Johnny judging each club or chapter must have a sign at each species to designate their name and area, and all animals must have an ID card, with the owner's name, on the pen. Pens should be decorated using the Fair's theme and have some educational value made with quality construction. Imagination will be taken into consideration.

Scorecard to be used:

CLEANLINESS OF ALLEYS, STALLS, PENS 50 pts.

- Bedding adequate, bright, dry and in place
- Animals securely tied or penned
- Feed boxes & pans in front of animal only at feeding times
- Manure hauled out and deposited in proper place

ARRANGEMENT OF EXHIBIT 10 pts.

- Exhibit lined up in an attractive manner
- Safe to walk by exhibit
- Large objectionable boxes out of the way
- Shavings neat and orderly
- Feed boxes, feed pans and tack in area provided

STALL CARDS..... 25 pts.

- Readable from alley
- Neatly arranged

MEMBER'S COURTESY 15 pts.

- Attendants on duty should conduct themselves in a courteous, friendly and helpful manner

DECORATIONS 25 pts.

- Attractive and educational decorations
- Appealing to the public
- Must be maintained throughout the fair
