It is an achievement, an honor and a privilege to represent our Imperial County. County Ambassadors are expected to set an example and challenge younger members to achieve their goals. Being selected as a County Ambassador means you are aware of the time commitment this position requires. Please give some serious thought to your other commitments such as: school activities/homework, personal interests, athletic desires and 4-H projects. Discuss your interest in applying for the ambassadorship with your parents and leaders.

To apply for this position, applicants must complete a current year 4-H Record Book on or before the Record Book due date of the current year, complete the attached application, review and sign the 4-H County Ambassador Contract, get a letter of recommendation from your Community Leader, prepare a County Ambassador interview presentation and provide your supporting documents for the day of the interview.

All completed documents must be scanned and emailed into the 4-H Office by 5pm on the last Friday in May to ilgarcia@ucanr.edu. Interviews will be held during the first week in June (time to be announced). Interviews will be held via Zoom.

Imperial County 4-H Ambassador Information

County Ambassador is the highest attainable County 4-H rank. It is awarded each year to a selected number of older 4-H members who have made or would like to make a significant contribution to the 4-H Youth Program in our county.

Requirements

- 1. Member must be at least 15 years of age by June 1st of application year.
- 2. Must be a member in good standing within their own 4-H Club.
- 3. Must have been a 4-H Member for at least 2 years prior to submitting an application.
- Must have been a club officer for at least one year within their 4-H club. 4.
- Ambassadorships are a two-year term. (Exceptions will be made for incoming high school Sr. 5. Applicants)

Duties and Responsibilities

- Each County Ambassador team will plan and carry out a specific program (i.e., improve on a current 1. county activity, develop or expand a specific county activity).
- County Ambassadors will be actively involved in a leadership role at County events. 2.
- County Ambassadors will attend 4-H Council meetings and present a monthly report that updates 3. Council on activities and events.
- 4. County Ambassadors are encouraged to attend Regional 4-H Leaders' Council meetings
- County Ambassadors and their parents will attend an orientation meeting that outlines duties and 5. responsibilities.

Awards

- County Ambassadors will receive a pin, emblem, jacket, and shirt provided by the Imperial County Leaders Council.
- 2. Registration Expense-paid trip to the State Leadership 4-H Conference at the University of California Davis by the Imperial County 4-H Council. (Does not include transportation)

Selection

A County Ambassador Committee will be selected by the 4-H Council. The County Ambassador Committee will review each application and references, interview each candidate, and then select the Ambassadors based on total 4-H accomplishments, commitment to the program, and leadership ability in contributing to the County 4-H Program.

County Ambassador Presentation Plan

As part of the interview process, applicants will be required to give a 3-5 minute presentation on the topic listed below. Presentation order will be randomly selected. Visual aids (props) and digital slides may be used (Zoom Screen Share option available). Evaluation of presentations will be based on the basic 4-H Presentation Guidelines, including: presentation of subject to judges, knowledge of subject, creativity, professional demeanor, voice, eye contact and answering questions.

Presentation Topic:

Provide a concept for a new county-wide project that incorporates one of the 4-H mission mandates (Science/SET, Healthy Living, Citizenship and Thrive). Explain how you would promote engagement with all clubs, and what the overall goal would be, including your long-term vision. Information on mandates can be found here: http://4h.ucanr.edu/Projects/
