



Food Systems Resilience




Food systems resilience is "the capacity over time of a food system and its units at multiple levels, to provide **sufficient**, **appropriate**, and **accessible food** to all, in the face of various and even unforeseen **disturbances**." (Tendall et al., 2015)

- 3. Enhance community food security & build community resilience.


Regional Network

Local Procurement

- Develop policy, practice, & economic recommendations for local producers to sell to emergency food purchasers







Increase Food Security & Resilience



- Work with community organizations to strengthen local-level emergency food networks

- Integrate feeding plans into local & tribal government emergency response efforts
