

# SHOWY MILKWEED ASCLEPIAS SPECIOSA

#### Please note:

It takes about one year for native milkweed plants to get established!

These perennial plants go dormant in the Winter, but will re-emerge in the Spring!

## Meman

\*Milkweed is the only plant the monarch caterpillar can eat! Please let them eat as much of your milkweed as they'd like!

#### **PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Wait until the last frost has passed before planting and dig into the ground to loosen soil. Mix planting location soil with a nice organic potting soil (1:1 ratio).
- 2. Remove milkweed start from pot/tray, place in hole and cover with soil mixture up to the base of the stem.
- 3. Water the milkweed in after planting.
- 4. Log your planting on the Monarch Milkweed Mapper: <a href="https://www.monarchmilkweedmapper.org">www.monarchmilkweedmapper.org</a>
- 5. Keep ground evenly moist for the first 2 weeks after planting, and then water 1-2 times per week or as needed based on plant behavior.
- 6. Cut plants down to 3" above the ground in December.

- Plant Type: Perennial herb
- Size: 4 6 ft tall, 4 ft wide
- Form: Upright, Spreading, Upright Columnar
- Growth Rate: Moderate
- Flower Color: White, Pink, Purple
- Flowering Season: Summer
- Dormancy: Winter Deciduous
