Introduction to the Event:

This contest is great to challenge members on their oral and written communication skills. The Interview Contest is a popular event that gives 4-H Members an opportunity to practice real-life skills needed to apply for a job. Participants prepare a resume and cover letter for a job they choose from the job descriptions provided on the Glenn County 4-H website, provided by the California State 4-H Interview Contest. Members will have their performance evaluated during a mock interview and receive constructive feedback from evaluators, using a standard evaluation rubric.

Any 4-H member may participate in the 4-H Job Interview Contest in the Junior Division (9-10 years old), Intermediate Division (11-13 years old), and Senior Division (14-18 years old), as of December 31, 2023.
