MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Council Incentives – The Advisory Team had an open conversation, inquiring about what other counties do to encourage participation and if they incentivize opportunities to encourage recruitment. One suggestion is to incentives a few events that are lacking participation, but hold weight in various areas in our program, such as Tractor Supply Fall and Spring Paper Clover Campaign, 4-H Fair Cookhouse, and the Fundraiser Dinner. This suggestion will be brought to the Community Town Hall for open conversation and input.

Glenn County 4-H Fair Exhibition Requirements – The item was added to the Advisory Team Agenda with the intention of bringing it to the Community Town Hall Meeting. We want to know how leaders and families feel meeting the requirements and how they are going for them, and provide an opportunity for general comments.

Program Planning and for the 2024-2025 program year – The conversation was brief and we discussed the need for more support in event planning and what that could look like in the new program year. One solution is to move forward with an Event Committee Chair planning meeting and develop a plan and timeline from there. Hoping this will also help support the Key Leaders and bring in more families to be a part of the program planning.

Purchase Approvals – We will move forward with purchasing new coffee pots prior to fair week and borrow Glenn County Farm Bureau's for the dinner. Christine Kampmann (4-H CES) presented the Leadership Overnight Opportunity in Santa Clara County, that a Glenn County 4-H youth Member registered for. The topic of discussion was focused on the Leadership Opportunity Scholarship and how much to allow to encourage youth to attend. Lisa Humphreys made a motion to approve three youth members at \$200.00 each, and the participant paid the remainder of \$75.00 to attend. If more youth applied, then we would have a further discussion and reevaluate the amount of funds allotted. The motion was seconded by Lucas Rmairez.

Meeting Vision – This item was tabled until the next meeting.

Moving forward next program year with the Advisory Committee – This item was tabled until the next meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
