

SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE REPORT

The Senior Scholarship Committee held interviews on Monday June 3rd at the Monterey County 4-H office. Four senior members applied for a \$1,000 scholarship. We had a panel that consisted of four adult volunteers: Anita from Natividad 4-H, Crystal from Mission 4-H, Lina from Spring 4-H, and Allie from King City Rural. That panel then interviewed the four seniors and pre-reviewed their applications for completeness at the 4-H office. These members qualified for the leadership scholarship by completing county level positions, such as youth committee chair for a council committee, being a camp counselor at least once, being a council co-officer, completing an emerald star, or had been on the old youth council. All members also submitted their application by the deadline and all were complete including having two letters of recommendation from adult volunteers.

Afterwards, the committee made their recommendations to adjust areas of the process such as cleaning the layout of the rubric and giving more time for the interviews as 15 minutes seemed to be rushed. The scores have been given to the council president, and final results will be posted after the program year ends. Thank you.
