Login Instructions

A. If you already have a CITI account:



- Step 1. Go to the CITI Program at www.citiprogram.org and click Log In in top right-hand corner.
- Step 2. Enter your username and password to log in to the CITI account.
- Step 3. Under “Institutional Courses” Click “View Courses” in front of “University of California Division of Agriculture & Natural Resources” to view your current courses with ANR.
